#### **SPRING 2016**



Twenty years ago Karon Wright and businessman Roger McKechnie hatched an ambitious plan to bring the world's best artists together with talented young professionals under one roof to work, perform and be inspired.

From the very first concert given by Katarina Karnéus, who had just won the BBC Cardiff Singer of the World Competition, and the poet Tony Harrison, in a converted barn on Windermere, Samling has blossomed into an internationally renowned centre for excellence. As we turn twenty we are proud of our legacy which stretches across the globe through the outstanding singers and pianists who have received Samling's unique training.

Over the coming months our twentieth anniversary celebrations include a spectacular birthday concert in the beautiful grounds of the Old Vicarage at Bywell in Northumberland in July, our very special Anniversary Masterclass and Showcase at Wigmore Hall in November with Sir Thomas Allen and, rounding off our birthday in early 2017, a 'Coming of Age' Gala Concert with the Royal Northern Sinfonia at Sage Gateshead.

Our Samling Artist Programme week in February welcomes for the first time the acclaimed mezzo-soprano Ann Murray DBE, as well as international baritone Olaf Bär and pianist Caroline Dowdle. You can join our distinguished leaders and eight Samling Artists at Sage Two on Saturday 27 February for a Masterclass, during which the audience supports the work on stage. The afternoon is rounded off by a short concert showcasing the repertoire highlights from the week.

When Samling Academy was established in 2012 one of our main aspirations was that participants might eventually return to us as young professionals to take part in our Artist Programme. We are therefore truly delighted that North East born soprano Rowan Pierce will be one of the eight Samling Artists joining us in February. Samling Academy participant Rowan's return to us as a young professional completes a 'virtuous circle' of learning and development.

Throughout the Spring work continues with Samling Academy and through our new initiative Samling Futures. This has been established to widen access and break down

perceived barriers to classical music by inviting students from every middle and high school in the North East to come to a 'Taster Day' in February. Two Summer concerts are also planned giving further performance opportunities to Academy participants and, following six days of intensive study at the start of the new academic year in October, we will once again present a Samling Academy Concert on Sunday 23 October at Sage Gateshead.

In November we will welcome Angelika Kirchschlager, Patricia MacMahon and Malcolm Martineau to lead our final Artist Programme week of the year. Our anniversary celebrations conclude with a 'Coming of Age' Gala Concert on Friday 17 February 2017 with Samling Artists from over the years and members of our Academy with Royal Northern Sinfonia, so please save this unmissable date in your diary.

As Samling enters its twentieth year we thank each and every one of the artists, audience members, friends and colleagues who have supported us along the way and hope very much that you will join us throughout the year to celebrate. Here's to the next twenty years.

### Introduce a Friend



As a charity that receives no regular or statutory funding we need to raise significant funds to sustain our work and inspire the next generation of young artists. Samling Friends are at the heart of our creative community and help make the Samling experience

We recognise that often the best way of meeting someone is to be introduced by a mutual acquaintance and, with that in mind, we are writing to all existing Samling Friends in the coming weeks to ask them to Introduce a Friend and how to do so. We are pleased to offer a free ticket to one of our Samling Artist Programme events for each new Friend, as well as for the existing Friend who recommends them.

'In this special year for Samling we are very keen to increase the number of Friends, who are so important to us in supporting the charity,' said Chair of Samling Friends, Paul Stockdale. 'Experience has shown that many people only need to be introduced once for them to embrace all that Samling and its young artists have to offer.'

The cost of Friends' membership has remained the same for the past three years but from 2016 the membership fee will increase slightly to £40 annually. We are also introducing a new 'Couples' rate of £60 for a joint membership. An increasing number of our Friends choose to pay for their membership via Standing Order and from January Samling is offering the option to pay in quarterly instalments as well as the existing option of one annual payment.

All Friends of Samling receive a complimentary drink in the company of emerging and international stars after events at Sage Gateshead, assisted ticket booking if required and, should they wish, acknowledgement in our concert programmes. We are as ever hugely grateful to all our Friends for their continued support.

### Academy to **Professional**

Soprano Rowan Pierce will become the first ever Samling Academy participant to return to us as a young professional taking part in Samling Artist Programme in February.

From Saltburn-by-the-Sea in the North East of England, Rowan is currently studying at the Royal College of Music. She was one of over 120 highly talented young singers to attend Samling Artist Programme auditions last year, successfully winning one of only twelve places available.

'Samling is a truly unique organisation and has already given me a wealth of experience for which I will always be grateful. I feel very proud to have come from an area where music and my profession are taken so seriously and looked after with so much care,' said Rowan.

She added: 'As a participant in Samling Academy I felt very safe in the hands of all the leaders and the ambition to become a Samling Artist was always at the back of my mind. The fact that I am now moving on to be a Samling Artist in such a nurturing organisation makes me feel like I am entering students winning places in conservatoires a family of some of the most respected musicians that our industry has to offer. I am very excited to continue my Samling journey.'



The week-long Samling Artist Programme will give Rowan the chance to work intensively with some of the world's greatest artists in a highly supportive environment, learning, working and gaining inspiration from distinguished professionals including Ann Murray DBE, Olaf Bär, Caroline Dowdle and Italian vocal coach Valentina di Taranto.

'Rowan's achievement provides further evidence for the success of Samling's Academy, a unique educational model and, judging from the number of recent Academy right across the UK, we believe that she will be the first of many,' said Samling's director Karon Wright.

# Samling Futures

Samling Futures – an extension of Samling Academy - seeks to widen access to classical music for young people in the North East. A 'Taster Day' in February will introduce young singers to what Samling Academy has to offer, whilst a series of 'Development Weekends' will offer additional support to existing Academy participants and those who have shown potential.

Pupils in Years 8-12 from all schools in the North East are to be invited to take part in the **Taster Day**, which will be held on Saturday 13 February. The day will provide an idea of what it is like to take part in Samling Academy through group sessions, workshops and masterclasses. We will also be giving some handy audition tips as well as holding a Q&A session for any burning questions.

Hosted by our project partners, Newcastle and Durham Universities, Development Weekends will take place throughout the Spring. The focus will be on singing technique and interpretation providing additional training for those who need support not available elsewhere.

As part of the ECHO Rising Stars programme and following on from



their work last year with the Academy, Samling Artists baritone Benjamin Appl and pianist James Baillieu will also offer in-depth coaching to Samling Academy participants in a day of masterclasses focusing on German repertoire.

'We believe that in every school there is at least one young person with a voice that they have never found because they haven't been given the opportunity,' said Samling Creative Development Manager Mary Emmett.

'Through Samling Futures we aim to change that by giving as many young people in this region as possible the chance to benefit from both the wonderful experience of classical singing and the high quality of training that Samling offers.



### Ann Murray joins Samling's Leadership team

We are delighted to announce that celebrated mezzo-soprano Ann Murray **DBE joins the Samling Artist Programme** leadership team for the first time in

Born in Dublin, Ann has sung at the world's most prestigious opera houses and concert venues: she has especially close links with the Royal Opera House and English National Opera where she has sung numerous title and principal roles, and is particularly noted for her performances of Handel, Mozart and Richard Strauss.

In 1997 Ann Murray was made an Honorary Doctor of Music by the National University of Ireland, in 1998 she was made a Kammersängerin of the Bavarian State Opera and in 1999 an Honorary Fellow of the Royal Academy of Music. In the 2002 Golden Jubilee Queen's Birthday Honours she was appointed an honorary Dame

Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire and in 2004 she was awarded the Bavarian Order of Merit.

'Ann Murray will bring a wealth of knowledge and experience to the young singers and pianists taking part in our first Artist Programme week of the year and we are looking forward to welcoming her to the Samling family,' said director Karon Wright.

Ann will be joining Olaf Bär, Caroline Dowdle and Italian vocal coach Valentina di Taranto to instruct eight Samling Artists during a week of intensive training and development culminating in our public Masterclass and Concert at Sage Two on Saturday 27 February.


